This refers to Bill 83 tabled by the Minister of Health on the practice of medicine. AREQ, along with other groups, wrote an open letter to call for concerted actions for this bill to go further in protecting our public health system.

In June 2024, the government launched the "Pride in Aging" Action Plan, that includes 102 measures. AREQ considers 13 of them to be substantial and realistic. AREQ also produced a brief entitled "Pour un virage audacieux en soutien à domicile : le Québec n'a plus le luxe d'attendre", with 5 proposals.

This is the amount awarded to three artists who received grants from AREQ to encourage Québec cultural production, in partnership with Impératif français, on the occasion of the 2024 Francofête.

This is the number of people who will be invited to take part in a survey on the different forms and representations of grandparenthood in Québec. The results of the survey, conducted by INRS in partnership with AREQ, will be made public in the summer of 2025.

6895

That is the total number of promotional items ordered to date from AREQ's online store. Prices range from \$1.75 for pens to \$76.95 for a magnificent jacket in AREQ's colors. So many ways to express our attachment to our association!

AREQ staff have designed and made available to our members around 10 conferences and training sessions on a variety of subjects, including artificial intelligence for seniors, insurance, home care, sexual diversity, etc. Hundreds of members have attended.

On October 1, 2024, the International Day of Older Persons, more than 600 people took to the streets of Québec City for a march organized by AREQ in partnership with the Habitat movement, under the theme "Let's walk for well-being".

\$1.1 billion

In the fall of 2024, IRIS published a study paid for by AREQ that paints a portrait of the situation of public home care and support services. and made recommendations for consideration by the Québec government. According to the study, potential annual savings from a shift to home care and support services in Québec could reach \$1.1 billion.

This is the RREGOP capitalization rate, which led to an additional indexation payment for pensioners in 2024. In response to representations from groups such as AREQ, the government agreed to pay its share of the indexation, which came to 2.2%.
